

CAMP KILLOOLEET CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT CHECKLIST

Dirty clothes are washed once a week. Our laundry service takes three days, so clothes for 10 days are needed. Any clothing that needs dry cleaning or hand washing should be so labeled and your child told. We have no uniform, but comfort and style are urged. On wet, chilly days, only sufficient protection enables comfort. Sweatshirts are not as warm as sweaters. An old winter jacket comes in handy. Wet sneakers dry very slowly; we urge one pair of rain boots or waterproofed hiking boots for rainy days.

Mark everything and you will get it back. Please label hats, shoes, sleeping bags, and mitts, as well as things that go in the laundry. A laundry marking pen or permanent marker usually lasts one season. Put names (not just initials) in an obvious place such as the corner, neck, or waist. Stamped names blur illegibly after several times through the washer, and iron-on tapes wash off.

Check your luggage at the end of the summer. If your child is missing something important, please call us right away. We store named articles and pass them back the next summer. Unnamed articles are given away.

*** For those flying in from a great distance, we offer to rent starred items for the season.** (\$25 for camping equipment, \$45 for linens and blankets.)

Clothes

- 2-3 swimsuits
- 12 underwear (for daily change)
- 14 prs. socks (2 pr. sports or wool sox for hiking)
- 4-6 prs. long pants/jeans
- 4-6 prs. shorts
- 2 pr. pajamas (heavy advised)
- 8 T shirts or equivalents
- 5 long sleeved shirts (turtleneck?)
- 2 heavy shirts (flannel, wool)
- 3 sweaters/jackets (1 wool or heavy fleece!)
- hat for games/trips in the sun
- 1 pr. everyday sneakers
- 1 pr. smooth soled tennis sneakers
- 1 pr. sturdy shoes (waterproofed for hiking, rain, trips)
- 2 large sweatshirts to keep warm after swim, hooded if possible
- 1 other pair (Texas? riding boots?)

Linens & Toilet Articles

- 4 woolen blankets or equivalents

-] 4 single cot sheets
-] 2 pillow cases
-] 1 pillow
-] 4 towels (not larger than 28"x48")
-] 2 washcloths
-] 2 laundry bags
-] 1 bar soap and soap box
-] comb and brush
-] toothbrush and toothpaste
-] shampoo, conditioner
-] sunscreen
-] 12 large safety pins, to pin socks to launder

Optional Equipment

-] writing paper, stamps, pens
-] camera and film
-] clothes for dances, theater, trips
-] baseball mitt, bat
-] tennis racquet
-] favorite books, games, tapes
-] stuffed animal
-] Walkman or CD player w/headphones
-] motion sickness medicine, if used
-] special interest equipment
-] musical instrument
-] If your child wears glasses, send an extra pair or prescription.

Essential Camping Equipment

-] backpack (school backpack ok, with waist strap preferred)
-] bicycle w/kickstand & rat trap
-] flashlight
-] knife (only if used to using one!)
-] canteen or Nalgene water bottle
-] sleeping bag
-] cooking kit or plastic bowl & cup
-] poncho/raingear
-] knife, fork & spoon
-] insect repellent
